Nature and Scope of Work:

This position combines front line work as a behavior therapists along with the role of Program Assistant (an assistant manager and administrative role). Behaviour Interventionists typically work one-on-one or in small pairs or pods, typically in client homes, with individuals with Autism and other diverse abilities. They implement client specific programming developed by our team of professionals to quickly teach skills and reach each family's stated goals.

Work is done in client homes so a reliable vehicle is necessary.

You will work with the same clients for an extended period of time, so we request a one-year commitment.

Qualifications:

We are looking for candidates with:

- At least 3 months experience (volunteer, practicum or paid) working with special needs populations (preferably autism but work with other diverse abilities are also strongly considered)
- Post-secondary education in a related area of study such as: Disability and Applied Behaviour Analysis, Special Education Assistant, Child & Youth Care, Early Childhood Education, Counselling, Psychology or Social Work, Community Support Worker, etc .
- Ability to set boundaries with compassion and consistency
- Dependability & consistency in attending sessions
- Basic computer skills
- Flexible schedule

Program Assistant:

General Description:

The successful candidate will be responsible for case administration, staff leadership and training, and providing direct support to client families. As an assistant manager, Program Assistants oversee the implementation of intervention plans by other frontline Behaviour Interventionists and Child Care Workers.

Program Assistants also provide these front line services to clients for much of their work week in combination with the administrative work that is required as a Program Assistant. This is a position requiring keen attention to detail, mastery of social service skills, a solid knowledge of Autism and ABA, an outgoing personality, ability to work independently, and a willingness to learn and adapt to new models of service delivery.

For both positions, You MUST be able to provide the following:

- Proof that you are over 19 years old
- Willingness to complete a Criminal Record Check
- Willingness to obtain Emergency First Aid
- Willingness and ability to successfully complete NVCPI training directly through Pivot Point
- A reliable vehicle
- A valid Driver's License and a clean driving record (Driver's Abstract will be required)
