Nature and Scope

- Regional Managers work 50% or more of their hours from home based offices!

 15 hours per week and is likely to remain relatively stable once you establish routines... unless you want more!

- New client Intake: Completing information sessions with potential client families to present Pivot Point's services and help families determine if we are a good fit for their needs.
