- ✓ Have more than one year's experience working with children with autism
- ✓ Have worked with groups of 4 or more children, or feel confident in doing so
- Are dependable, enthusiastic and have leadership skills with children
- ✓ Are willing to share flyers and send emails about their upcoming groups at Pivot Point
- Can follow instructions, work with other Activity Leaders, and take data each day
- Can attend training sometime in the weeks/months before their Day Camp is scheduled to start
- Can commit to being available to run the Day Camp for each full week that they have chosen, from 8:30 am to 3:30 pm Monday through Friday
- Be available to work on late afternoons and evenings and/or weekends if desired
- Have some post-secondary courses in topics such as Disability & Applied Behaviour Analysis, Special Education Assistant, Child & Youth Care, Early Childhood Education, Psychology or Social Work, etc.
- ✓ Be 19 years of age or older, have current First Aid training, and drive their own car
