Posting Summary:

Behaviour Intervener / Childcare Workers (BI/CCW) serve as 'behaviour therapists' for children and youth with behavioral and emotional disorders and/or developmental conditions. Their purpose is to **CREATE POSITIVE CHANGE** within each client by implementing treatment plans as effectively as possible.

Behaviour Intervener / Childcare Workers work in client homes and local communities to implement therapeutic change strategies.

Are **YOU** able to work as part of a multi-disciplinary team including Behaviour Consultants (BC), Counsellors, Program Assistants and Occupational, Speech and other Therapists?

Can **YOU** take direction and implement treatment plans from a variety of Lead Professionals (most typically Behaviour Consultants and Counsellors) by working either in client homes, their local community, or within our community offices?

Duties and Responsibilities

- Complete data tracking and session notes after each shift
- Work with the same client for an extended period of time, so a one-year commitment is required
- Report to multi-disciplinary team per case, and generally to Regional Manager
- Have a reliable vehicle and a valid Driver's License with a clean driving record (Driver's Abstract will be required)

Qualifications

- Minimum 3 months experience working with special needs populations (preferably with autism but work with other disorders is also strongly considered)
- Post-secondary education in a related area of study such as: Disability and Applied Behaviour Analysis, Special Education Assistant, Child & Youth Care, Early Childhood Education, Psychology or Social Work, Community Support Worker, etc
- Basic computer skills as data-taking is required
- Daily access to internet is required
- Flexible schedule (Sessions are often requested in the morning, late afternoons (3-6pm) or weekends)
- Diverse languages are an asset
- Dependability & consistency in attending sessions
- Ability to express one's own needs and take initiative for the client's benefit
- Ability to communicate effectively with co-workers & parents
- Willingness to complete Criminal Record check and obtain Emergency First Aid

Working Conditions

- Willingness to work with clients who may exhibit challenging behaviors, including aggression.
- Willingness to follow safety protocols, including de-escalation techniques, regular team check-ins, and MANDT training.
- There is potential for workers to experience verbal aggression, such as swearing, or physical aggression, which could result in injury.
